- Founded in 2003 near Kolkata, with Just 3 Children in a Rented Building
- Present Reach : 4 States (West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh & Jharkhand)
- Areas : Child Care, Education, Health and Nutrition

RESIDENTIAL INSTITUTIONS IN WEST BENGAL

- West Bengal's Largest Free Residential Educational Institution for children from highly impoverished backgrounds.
- Parivaar provides Total Support – Schooling, Residence, Food, Medical support, Clothes etc.
- As of December '25 about 2100 resident children (1000 + boys & girls).
- 15 batches of our children have passed Grade 10 Board Examination. 98% of them have done so in their first attempt despite being late starters in school education.
- 13 batches of our children have passed Grade 12 Board Examination. 97% of them have done so in their first attempt despite being late starters in school education.
- More than 500 boys and girls have got gainfully employed after their skilling/employability program and/or University Level Education.




1. SEVA KUTIRS: Day-Boarding Supplementary Education-cum-Nutrition Centers

- Village community provided venue – zero infra costs.
- More than 70 thousand children served in 1049 villages across 22 districts in MP and 1 district each in Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand
- Education in morning & evening shifts along with light nutrition.
- Staff is mostly taken from the Local tribal community
- Community involvement in seva Kutirs through Various activities – health & village welfare & development Yoga, sports & other co-curriculars activities





EDUCATION AND NUTRITION IN SEVA KUTIR

- Categorisation of Students based on learning levels
 - **PRE-PRIMARY:** Age group: 4-7 Grades:1-2 & kindergarten
 - **PRIMARY:** Age group: 8-10 Years Grades: 3-5
 - **UPPER PRIMARY:** Age group: 11-14 Years: Grades: 6-8
- Languages, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Co-Curricular activities, Games and Sports.
- Engagement in Village awareness activities on days like Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti, World Yoga Day etc.
- Provision of Educational Resources like Pratham Mini-libraries, Workbooks, TLMs etc
- Regular Trainings of Teachers by Education Resource Persons
- Preparing Children for Admission into Special Govt. Residential Schools – Navodaya, Eklavya etc Vidyalayas – **more than 1000 children got selected in FY 25-26**

2. 24*7 AMBULANCE SERVICES

- **91 Ambulances** across 22 districts
- Operating 24*7 in Extremely Remote & Impoverished Tribal Areas
- Cater to 2-3 patients daily and run 100-150 kms.
- These have served more than **3.4 lakh** persons since inception in June 2021.
- Emergency transportation to nearest govt. hospitals
- Information about this is circulated among the Panchayat officials, village health workers etc.
- 2 drivers and 2 attendants on each ambulance for day and night shift



3. MOBILE MEDICAL CLINICS

- 51 Mobile Medical Clinics in 21 Districts
- Villages covered on fortnight basis : 2,661
- Cases served so far : 22 lakh +
- A Qualified Doctor Visits 4-5 villages daily & treats patients
- Daily 100-150 cases are treated & free medicines provided
- Patients who require more advanced care are sent to advanced facilities in Bhopal, Indore, Nagpur, Jabalpur, Gwalior, Delhi etc.



4. VISION RESTORATION PROGRAM

- Thousands of Persons, esp. Elderly, Suffer from Cataract & Other Eye Ailments
- We Collaborated with Some Highly Reputed & Big Eye Hospitals in the Region – Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust Hospitals in Chitrakoot & Vidisha, MP
- Patients are examined, given medication, and glasses during eye camps.
- Those in Need of Surgery are Taken to the Hospital by Parivaar where they are operated

5. RESIDENTIAL INSTITUTIONS IN MADHYA PRADESH

1. Village - Sandalpur, District Dewas

Area : 17 acres.

There are 1078 resident children (748 boys and 330 girls) in this campus at present studying in Grades 6 to 11. It has started from the Academic Session 2021-22. Children belong to impoverished tribal backgrounds from 9 districts of MP



2. Village – Amla Noabad, District Sehore

This campus has started functioning from July 2022. There are around 350 children from highly impoverished tribal communities of 6 districts in MP – Khandwa, Betul, Vidisha, Alirajpur, Barwani and Sheopur.



3. Mandla Town

We are running two hostels – Parivaar Bhagini Nivedita Sadan (for girls) and Parivaar Swami Vivekananda Vidyarthi Sadan (for boys) for children from impoverished tribal families of several villages in Mandla district. The hostels are in Mandla town, and the children are enrolled in the Government Schools in the town. There are around 177 (119 Girls and 58 Boys), studying in Grades 9 to 12. There are some children who are pursuing University education too.



Some New Programs

- **1. Enablement Mission** : empowering impoverished tribal communities by facilitating access to Govt. welfare schemes
- **2. Anaemia Mitigation Program** : Screening about 1 lakh children and adults for anaemia and providing suitable medication and nutritional supplements. Shrimad Rajchandra Sarvamangal Trust (SRST), Gujarat is helping us in this.
- **3. Solar power based Safe Drinking Water Supply** for Tribal Households of villages in Barwani district of MP
